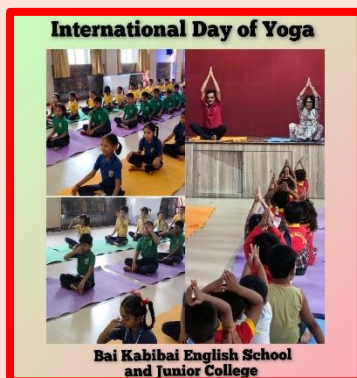
WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY

PRIMARY SECTION



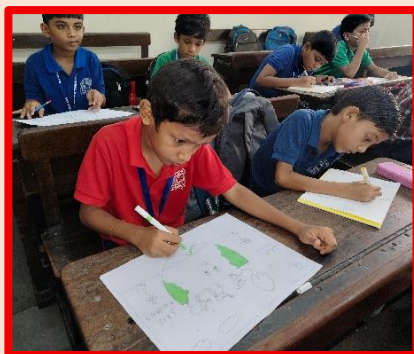
